NATICK TOURNAMENT FIELD DIRECTIONS

10U - Murphy Fields -- 155 North Main Street (Rt. 27)

Murphy North is closest to Rt. 27, Murphy South is closest the playground.

From North:

From Route 9, either East or West

Exit onto Route 27 South.

Murphy Fields will be approximately 200 yards on the left.

From South:

Route 27 North through Natick Center (is at Route 135 intersection)

Continue Route 27 North

Murphy Field will be approximately 1 1/2 miles on the right.

12U - Hunnewell Fields—26 Pleasant Street South

NOTE: For GPS directions, use Pleasant Street South as there is a different Pleasant Street in Natick

From North:

From Route 27 take Route 135 East 1/2 mile and take a right on Union Ave.

Follow Union Ave. and cross over Route 16 at traffic lights to Pleasant Street South.

Entrance to the Hunnewell Fields are approximately 500 feet on the left past the Charles River Waterfall.

From South:

From Route 27 or from Route 16; follow Route 16 East into Natick

Take a right onto Pleasant Street South at intersection of Union Street

Entrance to the Hunnewell Fields are approximately 500 feet on the left past the Charles River Waterfall.

14U - Memorial School Fields—107 Eliot Street

From North:

From Route 27 take Route 135 East 1/2 mile and take a right on Union Ave.

Follow Union Ave. to Route 16 (at set of lights) take right on Route 16 West, Eliot Street

Entrance to Memorial Elementary School is approximately 1/2 mile on right.

From South:

From Route 27 or from Route 16; follow Route 16 East into Natick

Continue to follow Route 16 East (Eliot St) to Memorial Elementary School at 107 Eliot on the left.

14U - Coolidge Field—30 Lincoln Street Extension

From North:

Take Route 27 South past Natick Center (is at Route 135 intersection)

Continue Route 27 South approx. 1/4 mile bear left onto Cottage Street

Cottage Street to second left onto Jefferson Street.

Coolidge Field is at the end of Jefferson Street.

From South:

Take Route 27 North for approx. 1 mile past Natick Town Line.

Take a sharp right onto Cottage Street

Cottage Street to second left onto Jefferson Street.

Coolidge Field is at the end of Jefferson Street.
